The impact of instructors is eroded when they encounter poor student writing.<sup>1</sup> We want to elevate the impact of instructors by dramatically reducing this time off task and by ensuring they're reviewing work that is transparently written by their students. We're achieving this by providing students with real-time, 24/7 assistive writing support. We're also developing powerful tools for instructors to see at a glance the genesis of a student's work and the role Al has played through their writing process.

## We will give every student assistive support so instructors can shift time from fixing writing to focusing on student coaching and course outcomes.





#### Evolve academic integrity

Did you know that 86% of students say they regularly use AI in their studies and that 50% say they would continue doing so even if gen AI tools were banned?<sup>1</sup> However, only 24% of administrators have implemented a policy on AI use. We want to help institutions advance their AI policies and instructional practices.<sup>2</sup> We're achieving this by developing tools for administrators to codify and control use of Al; deploy it selectively (e.g., by course, school, or year); and evolve their Al policies. We're also providing instructors with visibility into their students' use of Al.

# We will help institutions manage Al with confidence and scale with efficiency to evolve academic integrity and institutional practices.


### Deepen thoughtful deployment of Al

Higher education leaders want to implement AI, but they want to do so thoughtfully and with faculty buy-in. To support this, Grammarly will expand Authorship to provide insights into how AI is used in writing across campus. 
